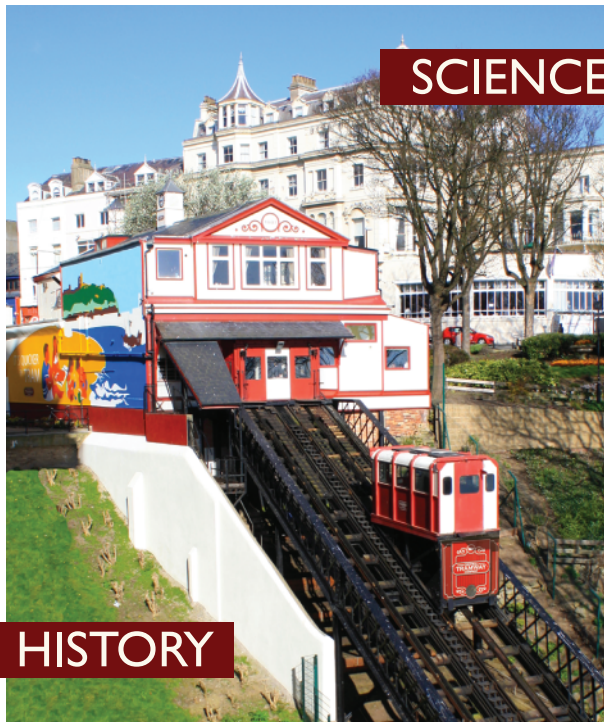


Take a journey back in time and experience Scarborough's Victorian past right on your doorstep.

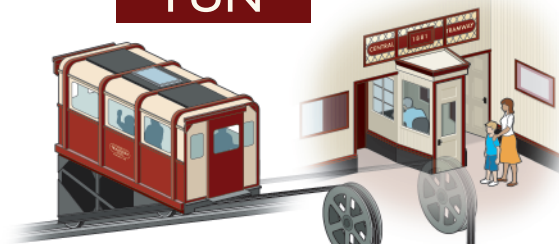

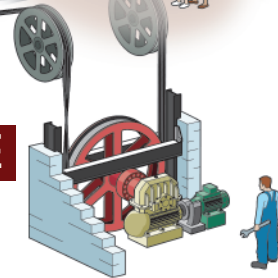

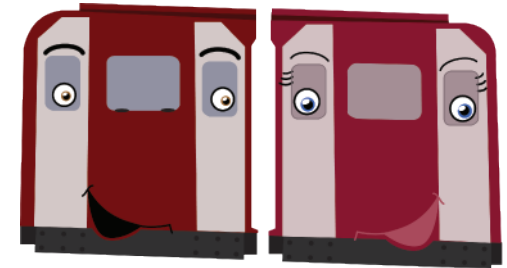
