The Central Tramway is a funicular railway, this means the 2 carriages are connected by 4 very strong wire cables (can you see them when you travel?).

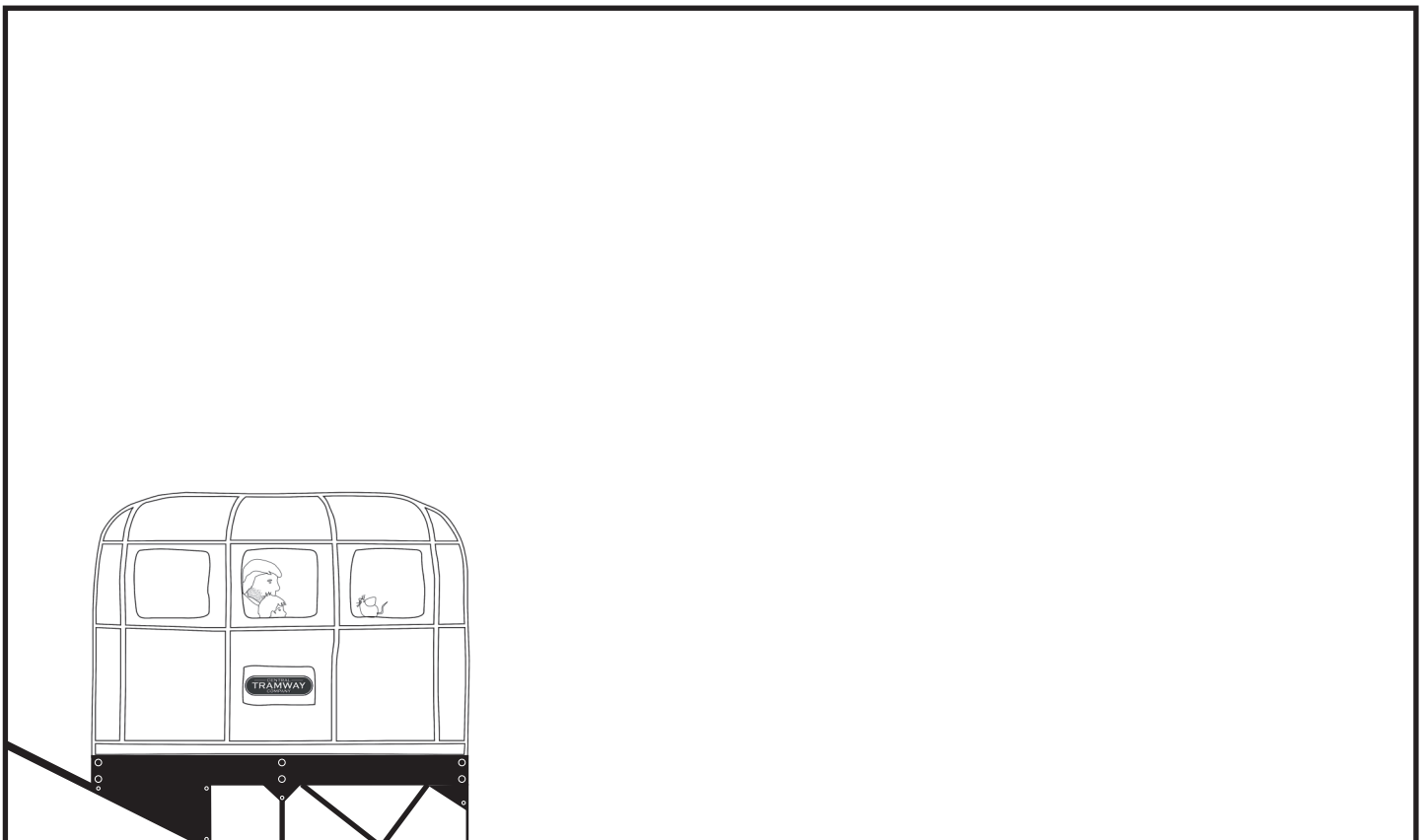
As one carriage goes up the hill, the other comes down. The 4 cables are strong enough to hold the 2 carriages plus the weight of 16 elephants!
